# Definitions & general conditions

Admission: Formality required to be authorized to play golf on the courses, upon application for membership and payment of stipulated fees.

Admission fees: Amount determined by management for the admission of a new member. These fees must be paid in full unless pre-determine terms have been arranged with management when applying for membership. This amount is non-refundable.

Admission confers a non-transferable and non-vendible personal entitlement. Payment does not constitute the purchase of a share in the club, only the right to use its facilities under certain conditions.

Management reserves the right to increase the admission fees. However, should management decide, at its discretion, to reimburse, the amount will be calculated on a prorated basis, only for the period of time elapsed versus the actual amount paid.

Contribution: Amount established every year as a subscription fee for the upcoming season. The amount varies according to membership category. A 2009 form (renewal form) must be completed by each member and submitted with payment as per the attachment included.

## Minimum consumption charges (bar bill):

A minimum amount of 565\$ (taxes and service charges excluded) is required per member for consumption charges made at its various restaurants and must be spent between May 1<sup>st</sup> and September 30<sup>th</sup> of each season. Members must pay a minimum of 113\$ or the entire amount of their expenses up to the required amount of 565\$. In the event where the monthly expenses are inferior to the minimum of 113\$, the difference will be credited to the member's account. Management may suspend the playing privileges of a member whose account remains unpaid. Furthermore, a late fee of 2% per month will be added to all unpaid accounts.

# Categories & privileges

## **01. Regular senior membership**

This member (male or female, any age) obtains the right to play at any time during the club's official opening hours. He may reserve a tee-off time up to seven days in advance, but must give at least 24 hours notice when cancelling. He benefits from the priority of playing on Des Seigneurs course as well as the possibility of playing Des Moulins and Des Braves courses, based on availability.

## **02. Senior couple membership**

Two members, one man and one woman, living in common law, obtain the right to play at any time during the club's official hours. Each one may reserve a tee-off time up to seven days in advance, but must give at least 24 hours notice when cancelling. They benefit from the priority of playing on Des Seigneurs course as well as the possibility of playing Des Moulins and Des Braves courses, based on availability.

## **03. Corporate membership – 7 days**

One or many members (illimited number) designated by the corporation paying the admission fees. He/they obtain the same privileges as a regular senior member except that he/they are limited to the first 50 rounds prepaid by the corporation. Each one may reserve a tee-off time up to seven days in advance, but must give at least 24 hours notice when cancelling. They benefit from the priority of playing on Des Seigneurs course as well as the possibility of playing Des Moulins and Des Braves courses, based on availability.

## **04. Corporate membership – weekdays**

One or many members (illimited number) designated by the corporation paying the admission fees. He/they are limited to the first 50 rounds prepaid by the corporation. They obtain the right to play from Monday to Friday (except on holidays) during the club's official opening hours. Each one may reserve a tee-off time up to 5 days in advance, but must give at least 24 hours notice when cancelling. They benefit from the priority of playing on Des Seigneurs course as well as the possibility of playing Des Moulins and Des Braves courses, based on availability.

## **06. Weekdays membership – 5 days**

This member (male or female, any age) obtains the right to play from Monday to Friday (except on holidays) during the club's official opening hours. He may reserve a tee-off time up to five days in advance, but must give at least 24 hours notice when cancelling. He benefits of playing priority on Des Seigneurs course and possibility of playing Des Moulins and Des Braves courses, based on availability.

## **08. Intermediate membership**

This membership is limited to full-time students aged 24 years and under. He obtains the right to play after 12:00 during the club's official opening hours. He may reserve a tee-off time up to three days in advance, but must give at least 24 hours notice when cancelling. He benefits from the priority of playing on Des Seigneurs course as well as the possibility of playing Des Moulins and Des Braves courses, based on availability.

## **10. Junior family membership**

This membership is reserved for the children (under age of 18) of senior members. He obtains the right to play after 12:00 during the club's official opening hours. He may reserve a tee-off time up to three days in advance, but must give at least 24 hours notice when cancelling. He benefits from the priority of playing on Des Seigneurs course as well as the possibility of playing Des Moulins and Des Braves courses, based on availability.

## **11. Social membership**

This member wishes to maintain his membership without exercising any of its privileges. Management will approve such memberships only under special circumstances and will be granted for two seasons only.

# Guests

All members may bring guests to the club, according to the privileges granted by their membership category. The following order of precedence has been established within each category. Members bringing guests must give precedence to those members in good standing who have scheduled their tee-off time.

## **Order of precedence:**

1. Senior members (regulars, couples and corporate)
2. Senior members (regulars, couples and corporate) and guest(s)
3. Weekdays members and guest(s)
4. Intermediate members and guest(s)
5. Junior family members and guest(s)

# Tournaments (non-members)

Management reserves the right to close all its courses occasionally during the season. These days will be inscribe in member's activities calendar and on members' boards.

# Special clauses

## **Reservations:**

- a. All members are limited to a single reservation per day. A second round may be played according to availability or at the discretion of management.
- b. To decide the sequence of reservations for Saturdays, Sundays and Holidays, management will resort to a draw. Request for starting times must be submitted to the club, in writing only, on Mondays by 16:00, at the latest.
- c. All members will be billed for a third absence (physical presence) should they fail to cancel their reservation 24 hours in advance.

## **Motorized golf carts**

Gives the right to use "half-a-cart" for a round of 18 holes per day for a maximum of 80 shared rounds, or 40 rounds if not shared. Whenever possible, the member may be obligated to share his car with another member or guest. Maximum of two carts per foursome.

## **Cancellation of privileges/expulsion:**

In the case of serious infractions or behaviour deemed inappropriate, a member's privileges may be suspended, revoked or permanently withdrawn. Alternately, management may choose to give the member a disciplinary reprimand. As a representative of its members, Le Versant Golf Club contributes in the development of regulations and in maintaining the rules of courtesy and golf etiquette.

As stipulated in the **special clauses section**, the fee is for *one round of 18 holes per day for a maximum of 80 shared rounds, or 40 rounds if not shared.*

From May 11<sup>th</sup> to October 10<sup>th</sup> 2011, no food or beverages may be stored in the lockers, privileges may otherwise be revoked.

Before October 10<sup>th</sup>, golf bag and pull cart should be remove from storage, as well as lockers must be emptied.

After such time, management reserves the right to open the lockers and store its contents in a common area.

In all the instances mentioned under the **services category**, management will at no time be responsible for the loss or theft of any personal property.
